### School Trips

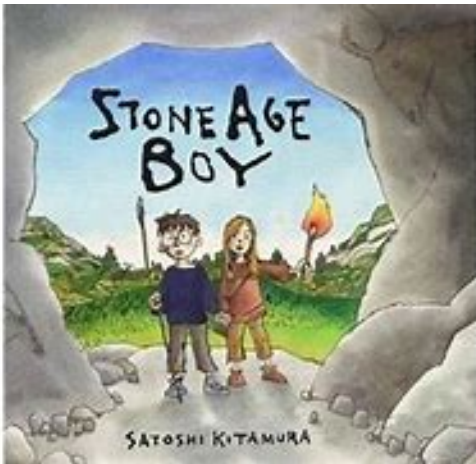
This half-term we will be going on an exciting immersive experience to Butser farm, where children will have the opportunity to really grasp what life was like during the stone age through a vast array of activities.

### English

This half term the children will have opportunities to write across different genres. We will be focusing our work on Stone age books (such as: Stone Age boy and Ug) and writing for a range of purposes, allowing the children to gain further understanding of this topic and also improve their writing simultaneously.

We will be building vocabulary and working on sentence structure as well as spelling strategies.

### Maths

In Maths we will be:

- Representing numbers to 100 then 1000
- Partitioning numbers to 100 then 1000
- Adding and subtracting across 100
- Adding 2 digit and 3 digit numbers
- Complements to 100
- Inverse operations
- Estimating answers

### Topic

This half-term we will be learning about the Stone Age. We will be covering what it is and how people lived during this era. We will also be looking at just how much has changed in Britain since these times and we will also be covering how metals really did transform life during this period.

Focusing on day to day existence and bringing many of the old Stone Age cave paintings to life and why they painted what they painted.
