## TRIPS

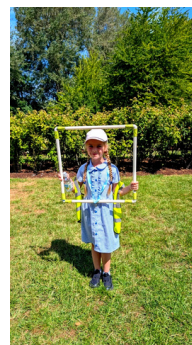
