### School Trips

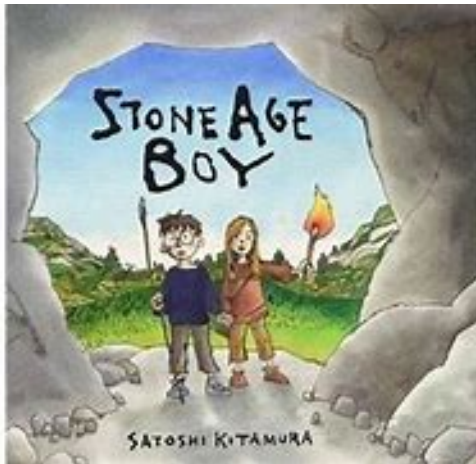
This half-term we will be going on an exciting trip to Painshill Park where children will have the opportunity to really grasp what life was like during the stone age through a vast array of activities.

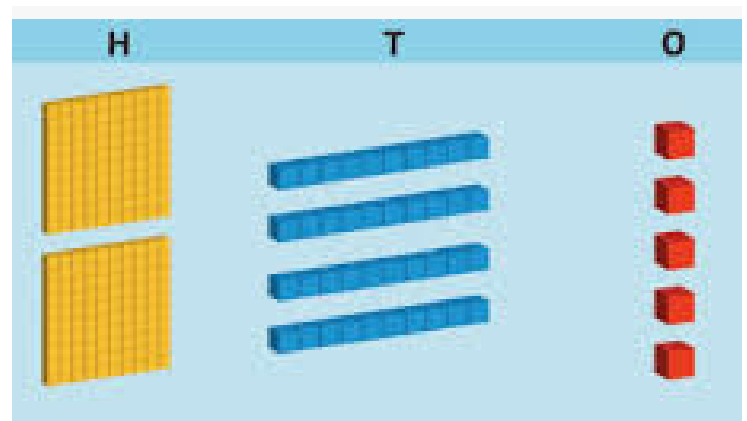
### English

This half term, the children will have lots of exciting opportunities to write in different ways. Our writing will be linked to our Stone Age topic, using books and stories from that time to inspire us. We'll be writing for different purposes, helping us learn more about the Stone Age while also improving our writing skills. We'll be building our vocabulary, working on sentence structure, and practising spelling strategies. The children will also take part in daily handwriting sessions to help develop neat and confident writing.

### Maths

In Maths we will be:

- Representing 3 digit numbers up to 1000 in different ways
- Partitioning numbers to 100 then 1000
- Adding and subtracting bridging 100
- Complements (number bonds) to 100
- Applying place value to measurements
- Problem solving



### Topic

This term in Year 3, we're stepping back in time to explore the fascinating world of the Stone Age! Through our History lessons, we'll learn about how early humans lived, hunted, and made tools, discovering what life was like thousands of years ago. In Art, we'll bring the past to life by creating our own Stone Age-inspired artifacts, including cave paintings and clay tools. It's going to be an exciting journey into the distant past as we learn through hands-on activities and creative projects!
