We are developing our sand area and mud kitchen so if you have any old wooden spoons that you could donate they would be put to good use!

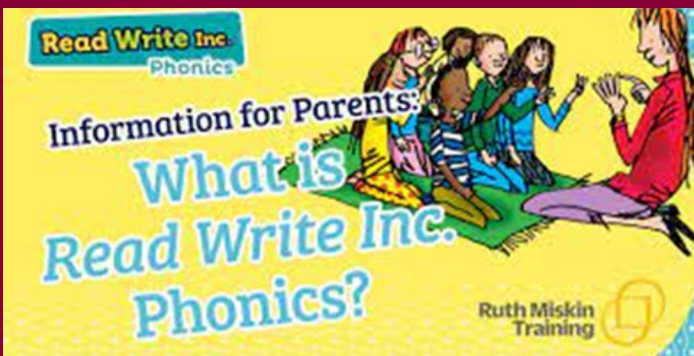

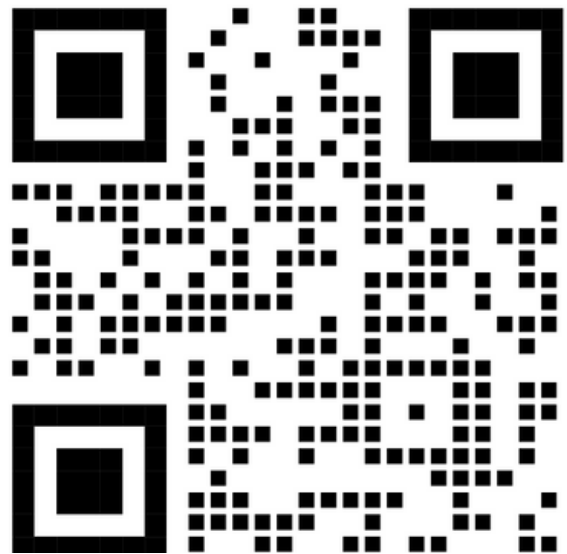


Phonics and Literacy
