Flourish at Hatfeild

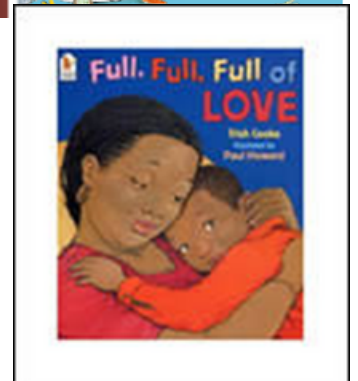


Nursery Entrance/Exit

Please drop off your child at the designated entrance in the morning and at lunchtime. Which is this door in the photo. Next to the main school entrance. For safety reasons, we kindly ask that you avoid using the backdoor, as it should not be left unlocked. At the end of both the morning and afternoon sessions, please collect your child from this same entrance.

Books we are reading

Ways to help at home

Please could you encourage your child to put on their own coat and shoes daily. These are important skills we will be helping your child develop throughout the term.

While we have facilities to change nappies, this does require two staff members to step away from the classroom, which can affect the learning experience for all of the children.
