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## Phonics and Literacy

At Hatfeild Primary we teach from the Read Write Inc scheme. In the beginning of the term we will be focusing on listening to sounds in our environment, this will lay a foundation for our children to practice listening to sounds to distinguish differentiation. We will then move on to the Set 1 speed sounds – more information to follow!

## Maths

In Maths, we will begin our term with matching and sorting. This will include matching and sorting objects, numbers and items. We will then begin our knowledge of the numbers 1, 2 and 3. We aim to ensure that all children have a deep understanding of what these numbers look like in all forms. Lastly, we will finish the term with measurement.



## Topic

Our Topic for this half term is the “Wonderful world of Me!”. We will be creating self portraits, looking at family photos, discussing where we feel safe and comparing cultures. The children will really explore what makes them unique. We will also be doing colour mixing in Art. In PSED, we will be learning about the Zones of Regulation and in PE we will be learning movement games.
