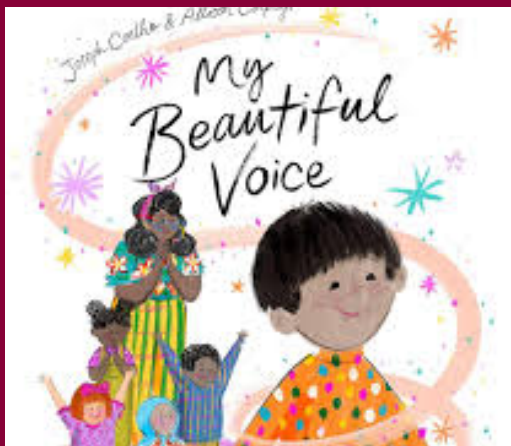

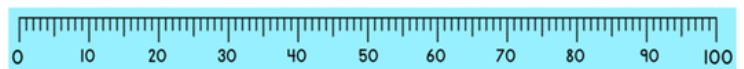
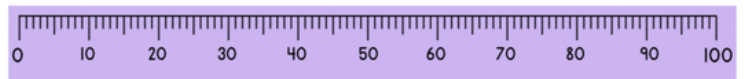


English

This term we will be looking at a variety of books all around 'Marvellous Me', and 'Flames and City Explorers'. We will be creating a character description, and writing instructions about how to find treasure! We will be learning about the great fire of London and writing a diary entry about what it was like.

Maths

This term we will be learning about numbers up to 100 and comparing different quantities. This will include adding and subtracting multiples of 10 and using our knowledge to explore length. We will also be considering part-whole relationships, what they can look like, and how to manipulate them.



Other subjects

In Autumn term, we will be learning about a variety of topics, including learning about the River Thames and writing our address in geography. In R.E., we will be learning about community and how the clothes we wear can represent different religions. In science, we will be learning about seasonal changes and everyday materials. In life skills we will be learning about how to care for ourselves; looking after pets; and staying safe. In PSHE we will be learning about how to work and play together.
