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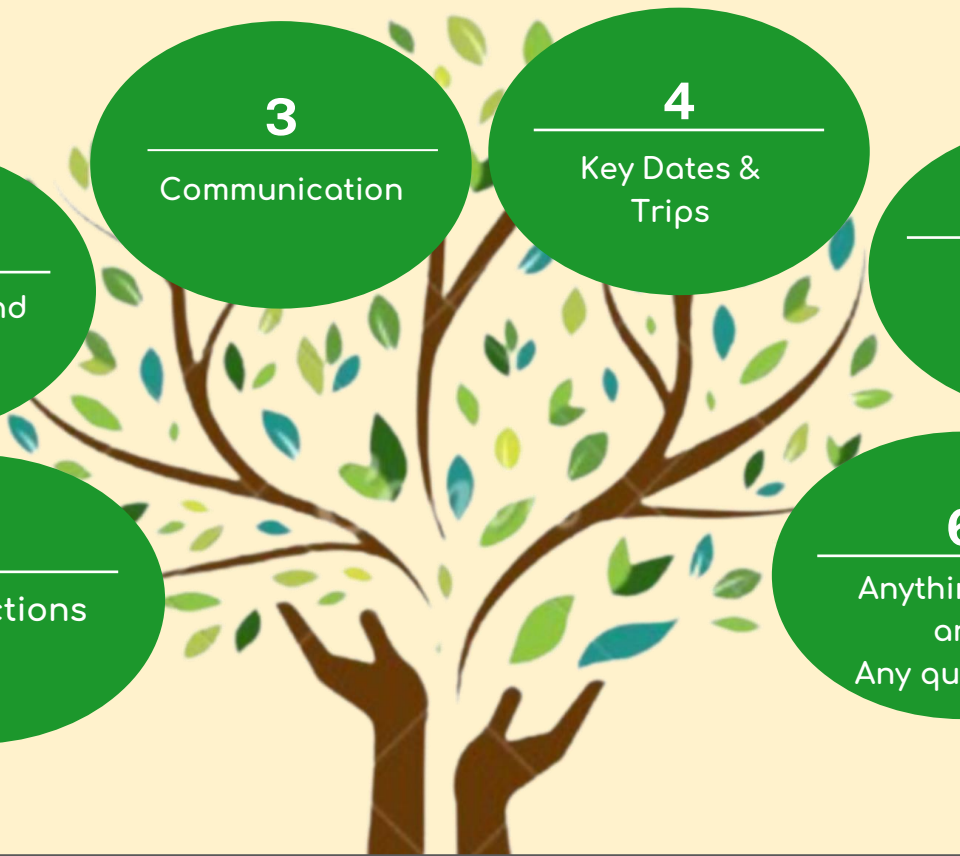

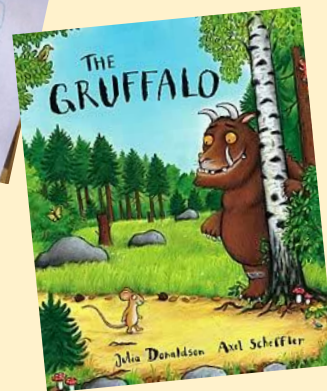

School Visits



School visits are fantastic learning opportunity for children to learn beyond the classroom. Each school visit we plan is linked to current learning and planned to enrich classroom practice.

However, in order to run, school visits need to be fully funded with enough adult volunteers to ensure that children are kept safe. If you would like a Volunteer DBS to help with school visits these cost around £20. Please email the school office.

Should we not receive enough payments to cover the cost of a school visit, or have enough volunteer support, we may need to cancel the visit at short notice.

To support with all future school visits and ensure we receive enough funding, on ParentPay there will now be a 'School Trip Fund' account set up. Here you can donate any amount you wish, added to your order to help a family that may not be able to pay.

Homework



Every Friday homework will be given to your child and will be due in on the following Wednesday. This homework centers around activities with your child at home rather than worksheet based.

If there are any problems or questions, please speak to your child's class teacher.

Home reading - Reading records should be sent back into school every day. Every child will be read to a minimum of once a week and we encourage you to read with your child at home. Please write what book you have read at home in the Reading Record!

Library - We aim to visit the library every week. Please ensure your child remembers to bring in their book. If they have not finished reading the book, they may keep it until next time.

Anything Else...



Just a reminder about snacks, please make sure your child/children have snack provided each day - we recommend a healthy snack such a fruit however we do understand for some of our children this may not be the most appropriate option, if this is the case please provide your child with an appropriate snack they wish to eat. (rice cakes, breadsticks etc)

Remember we are an allergen aware school and do not allow any products containing nuts in school.
