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Literacy & Phonics

For our first half term we will be focusing on a wide range of non fiction texts that revolve around vehicles. For our second half term we will be exploring texts about food such as Handa's Surprise and Oliver's Vegetables. In Phonics this term we are focusing heavily on our oral blending.



Maths

In Maths this term we will begin the term by recapping our previous term before diving into numbers to 10. We are ensuring the children have an in-depth knowledge on what these numbers look like in both numerical and non-numerical form.



Topic

In our first half term our topic is "Let's Get Moving" which focuses on vehicles. We will be exploring the names of different vehicles, what they look like and how we use them. This will be in a range of fiction and non-fiction books. The children will have opportunities to create maps, explore parts of vehicles and make their own out of junk modelling! In our second half term we will be learning from our topic "Fabulous Food". We will be exploring how food grows and how to keep ourselves healthy.
