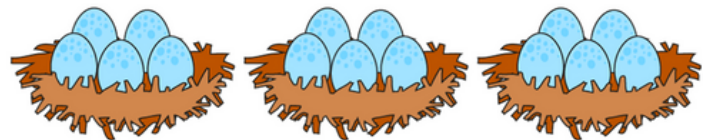


English

This term we will be looking at a variety of books travelling a little around the geographical world and the literacy world. We have started right here in England with 'The Dinosaur Lady', we will soon be exploring 'The Story Machine' and will be travelling all the way to Kenya with Wangary Maathai amongst others.

This term we will be learning about Multiplication and division – doubling, halving, learning the 2,4,8 times tables, then moving onto Shape and time.
