## Literacy & Phonics

In Summer 1, our books include; Commotion in the Ocean, Rainbow Fish, Tiddler, Sharing a Shell and The Singing Mermaid. We will also be introducing the children to non fiction books throughout both terms.

In Phonics this term we will be focused on oral blending as we have now completed our knowledge of all Set 1 Speed Sounds in the RWI Scheme. We will also be focusing on our letter formation through phonics and introducing capital letters and lowercase letters.

## Maths

In Maths this term, we will be focusing on numbers to 20 in both numerical and non numerical form. We will be using our knowledge of these numbers to begin basic addition and subtraction. At the end of this term we will be recapping our knowledge on shapes from the previous term.
