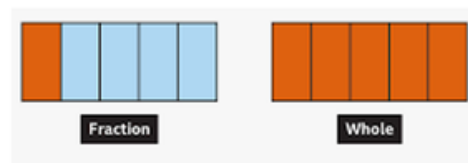


English
