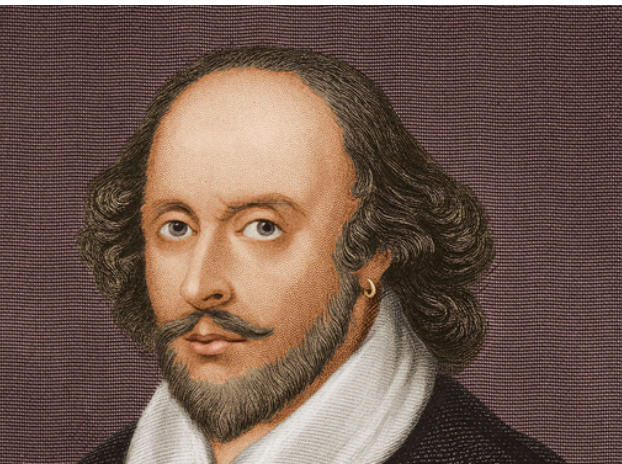

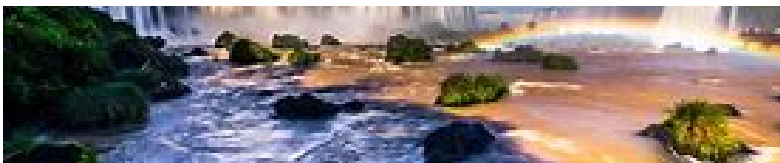

## News

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## English

This half term we will be focusing our writing around Shakespeare's Macbeth. After half term, we will be looking at the links to Windrush after the Second World War.

This term, in guided reading, we will be reading 'The London Eye Mystery' by Siobhan Dowd and 'On the Move: Poems About Migration' by Michael Rosen.



## Maths

In maths, this half term, we will be revisiting a range of specifics that we have previously covered that will come up in SATS such as: long multiplication, long division and fractions. After SATS we will be focusing our leaning towards mathematical projects (such as business enterprise) and preparing the children for Year 7.



## Topic

This term we will be learning about Windrush, through the book Windrush Child by Benjamin Zephaniah. We will be focusing on the role and importance the Windrush generation played in helping rebuild Britain after the Second World War. This heavily links to our Art and DT topics where we will be designing a Carnival outfit. Our Science this term is about light. For PE, our units will be rounders, cricket, tennis and athletics and these lessons will now take place on a Monday and Thursday. We are very excited that our cricket lessons will be delivered by coach Josh.
